Distribution company's security nightmare solved overnight by electric fence system – down from 4 crimes a week, to none in 12 months!



The head of an international logistics company has praised a new type of electric fence for solving major crime problems at his depot, where every other security measure failed. The Jeavons Eurotir warehouse site in Birmingham was being

hit by an average of four crimes every week – including raids on the offices, theft of vehicles and stock and vandalism to vehicles.

A succession of security measures, which failed to stop these attacks, included high security fencing, a monitored alarm system, remotely monitored infra-red CCTV and even nightly security guard patrols.

These features make it viable for applications where electric fences were not previously an option – in fact it is suitable for almost any site where perimeter security is a problem.

A short, sharp, painful but safe electric shock repels would-be intruders who come into contact with the system – the shock is even felt through clothing but is not dangerous.

Any attempts to cut, load, short-circuit or tamper with the PulseSecure™ system are detected, and alarms generated.

The system is the only one of its kind to be approved by the police under the Secured by Design scheme and has uniquely achieved the maximum Grade 4 rating for high security use in tests on behalf of the Home Office.

Harper Chalice has established a network of approved installers covering the whole UK, and parts of Europe, and the system has been commercially installed at a number of sites across the UK and Europe.
